What happened in 2025?

In 2025, several milestones were achieved bringing the project closer to completion. The final milestone is dependent on stable weather conditions and is scheduled to be completed in spring, prior to the facility becoming operational.

When will it be operational?

The Foothills Medical Centre Cogeneration Facility is expected to be operational by mid-2026. Moving forward, construction work will continue within the facility, and exterior work is expected to be minimal.

Once operational, will there be more steam releases?

As the facility approaches completion, shorter steam releases are anticipated as part of the commissioning process. For operation, the two generators and their piping are designed to minimize steam releases and releases would only occur to balance the system. We apologize for any inconvenience or disruption this may cause.

Can I access the area during construction?

Safety remains our top priority – for both the public and the workers on site. Thank you for your continued patience. While most areas around the site are now accessible, please continue to follow signage and respect construction barriers while work continues at the site.
